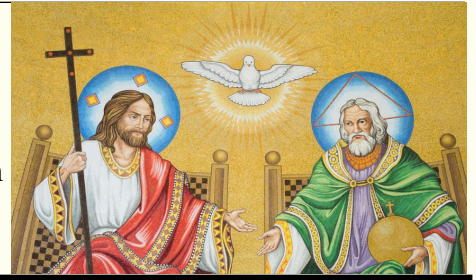

A Word from Fr. Jim: Sunday, May 26, 2024

Go only "to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."---- this was Jesus's firm instructions to the disciples when he first sent them out on mission. Later when a Canaanite woman pleaded with Jesus to heal her daughter, he again declared that he "was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." His concern was to feed his own people and he did not see her as one of them. It seems that her respectful and insistent response in word and in gesture, however, helped trigger a profound change in Jesus's understanding of the scope of his mission, At the end of the gospel, he commissions his disciples to go everywhere, making disciples of all nations.

A similarly profound shift occurred in the life of the apostle Paul, who went from persecuting Christians who were reinterpreting the parameters of the family of God to being the most ardent proponent of inclusion of all. In his writing later to the community of Rome he is able to say that all people who are led by the Spirit are "children of God." This same expression had been used of the Israelites. Paul presses the metaphor further, insisting that all these varied children of God are not just appendages to the family but are full and true heirs.

On this feast of the Holy Trinity, talk with Jesus about the ways you see "outsiders." What could turn your heart to see them more truly as God's beloved children? Also consider what names capture best for you the ever expanding communion of love that is the Trinity. Try out a new name for the Three-in-One in your prayer.
